EMOTIONAL SELF-CARE

ANXIETY: A SELF-HELP GUIDE FOR PEOPLE IN PRISON

This zine examines many aspects of anxiety and strategies for overcoming it.

COGNITIVE BEHAVIOURAL THERAPY (CBT) SKILLS TRAINING WORKBOOK

A self-help workbook based in CBT, a form of therapy that focuses on challenging negative thoughts. For anxiety and low mood. Not prison-specific.

DEPRESSION AND LOW MOOD: A SELF-HELP GUIDE FOR PEOPLE IN PRISON

This zine aims to help you cope with depression, offering practical solutions.

DIALECTICAL BEHAVIOR THERAPY (DBT) SKILLS WORKBOOK CHAPTER 1

Basic distress tolerance skills workbook based in DBT, which combines cognitive behavioural techniques with mindfulness and acceptance. Not prison-specific.

FREEING THE HUMAN SPIRIT THROUGH MEDITATION AND YOGA

A one-page illustrated guide to some basic yoga poses and meditation that can be done in prison.

HEARING VOICES COPING STRATEGIES

A list of strategies for coping with hearing voices, compiled by the Hearing Voices Network.

HOPE FOR HEALING

Information for survivors of sexual assault in prison.

HURTING YOURSELF

A workbook that aims to encourage reflection and awareness of many aspects of self-injury.

NAVIGATING CRISIS

A resource from the Icarus Project, which outlines what you can do when you or someone close to you is having a mental health crisis.

POST TRAUMATIC STRESS: A SELF-HELP GUIDE FOR PEOPLE IN PRISON

This zine aims to help you understand reactions to post-traumatic stress, offering practical suggestions to help you cope.

A guide which provides support and guidance for people going through mental health crises, from a non-judgmental and holistic perspective.

SUPPORT: SEXUAL ABUSE AND SURVIVORSHIP

A zine showing ways to prevent sexual violence and support survivors of sexual abuse.

SURVIVAL IN SOLITARY

A collection of writing, poetry and information about coping with solitary confinement and life sentences.

TAKING CARE OF YOUR BODY AND MIND

A pamphlet on safer slashing/safer cutting in prison.

TRYING TO UNDERSTAND SELF-INFLICTED VIOLENCE

A short zine about dissociation, and the reasons why people might choose to use self-injury to cope.

UNTREATED MENTAL ILLNESS IN PRISON

A comic by E.L. Tedana & J. Coffey who are both incarcerated in Texas. It discusses sleep deprivation and mental illness within the confines of prison.

THE VOICE INSIDE - A PRACTICAL GUIDE TO COPING WITH HEARING VOICES

An in-depth guide written by the Hearing Voices Network that explores what it's like to hear voices and how to cope better with the experience, along with a history and analysis of the Hearing Voices movement.

PHYSICAL WELLBEING

A PRISONER'S GUIDE TO HEALTH AND MEDICAL INFORMATION

A comprehensive guide to basic injuries and illnesses, with practical advice for cell treatments and what to expect from doctor's visits.

SAFER SEX

An article about how to reduce the risk of transmitting HIV/AIDS and other STIs when fucking without condoms. Not prison specific.

BEYOND APPEARANCES

A short overview of Florida trans prison policy, including relevant legal cases and advice about advocating for yourself. Written by Rayne Violet, longtime member of the project.

FUCKING TRANSWOMEN

A zine about sex by Mira Bellweather by and for transwomen on everything from anatomy to communication to touch to orgasms.

GETTING A GENDER DYSPHORIA DIAGNOSIS

A Prisoner Correspondence Project resource outlining the information your doctor is using to determine whether you have Gender Dysphoria. This booklet contains the Diagnostic Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5) chapter on Gender Dysphoria as well as some definitions, breakdowns and notes.

HEPATITIS C AND HORMONE THERAPY
